



*Cardboard Recycling Now Available to City Residents*

In cooperation with Granger, City residents may now recycle cardboard by depositing it in the large roll-off container located off the Railroad Street entrance to the City's Public Works Department at 303 South Jackson Street.

Rules for utilizing the container are as follows:

1. Dumpster is available for City resident use only.
2. The City pays to have the dumpster emptied - please breakdown/flatten boxes before placing in the dumpster.
3. DO NOT place cardboard outside of the dumpster. If dumpster is full - please recycle cardboard at a future date.
4. You MAY deposit the following with cardboard in this dumpster: boxboard, cereal boxes, cracker boxes, pasta boxes, paper egg cartons, pizza boxes, toilet paper/paper towel tubes, tissue boxes, shirt/shoe boxes and brown paper bags.
5. You MAY NOT deposit the following in this dumpster: foil coated boxes, wax coated boxes, beer or soda pop cartons, butter cartons, frozen food boxes, plastic coated boxes, newspaper, magazines and office paper.
